Eligibility. To be considered, the project representative must be a current ASHE member. Applications may be submitted by a hospital or hospital system employee, or by a consultant and/or other service provider, but a current ASHE member must be listed as the project representative.

Selection. Selections are based on project results and effect on patient care, not on size or cost. Nominations are evaluated by a select committee within ASHE volunteer leadership. ASHE's executive steering committee or board of directors provides final approval of the committee's selected winner.

The award recipient will be notified no later than October 8, 2021. ASHE will announce the winner during National Health Care Facilities & Engineering Week, October 24-30, 2021.

Obligations. The winning project team may be involved in a variety of efforts that educate the field about your innovative project. Some opportunities may include, participation on an ASHE committee or task force, participating in the awards presentation at the ASHE Annual Conference in 2022 or assisting with the development of a feature article for ASHE's Health Facilities Management Magazine.

Important: The entire submission (Section 1–4) must be submitted as one (1) electronic version in a PDF file format.

Please go to www.ashe.org/awards/facility_management to complete the online application. You will be required to upload two files 1) a PDF file of the entire application package and 2) separate file of supporting visual documentation i.e., photos.

Only one entry can be submitted from any single health care facility, although multiple entries can be submitted from a health care system as long as each entry is for a separate facility.

Applications must be received by Monday, August 9, 2021. The project representative for the award winning project will be notified by email, no later than October 8, 2021.

If the nominated initiative is considered, the project representative may be asked to participate in a formal interview with the committee to discuss and or explain the initiative.
