What is Energy to Care?

ASHE's Energy to Care Program is a confidential and complimentary energy reduction program that helps health care facilities track, manage and communicate energy savings.

How are hospitals using the program?

Operational Efficiency

Designed for all levels of energy management experience, the program supports facilities with limited time and resources. By using tools like benchmarking and energy exercises, hospitals have achieved significant energy savings.

Save on Utility Bills

The Dashboard offers financial analysis tools that examine a building and even the portfolio's utility bills.

- Bill Analysis displays cost values of each utility type (i.e. water, gas, electric) by month.
- **Utility Portfolio** that displays the selected building's utility consumption and cost in comparison to other buildings within the organization.
- Utility Gap Analysis displays an interactive graph and table that is used to isolate utility bill integrity issues to ensure no bills are missing or overlap.

Simple, daily changes—just 15 minutes with the Dashboard—can impact nearly half of a facility's utility expenses.

No duplicate efforts

Energy to Care has the ability to import existing building data from ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager and can synchronize and eliminate duplicative efforts by staff.

Ability to back up your data
